Blue Mountain College is a small, co-educational school catering for students aged between 11 and 19 years of age. It has a student roll of about 240.

The school is located in the town of Tapanui, which has a population of around 900 people.

The College has spacious grounds for all major sporting codes, including access to the golf course adjacent to the school.

Fees: Tuition \$10000; Homestay 46 weeks @\$200 = \$9200; Contingency Fund \$2000 (Uniform, NCEA/IELTS/TOEFL examination fees; Activities outside the normal school curriculum). The Contingency Fund is optional and can be used for the items listed. This money is kept in the student's account and any monies over at the end of the year will be refunded to the student.
