### FACTS

- 5 minutes drive to city centre and University of Otago.
- Accept students from Years 7 – 13 [students from 11 – 19 years of age].
- 650 students including 60 internationals from 10 different countries.
- The NZ school year is divided into 4 school terms
- Term start dates for **2012**:
  - Term 1** 1st February - 5th April
  - Term 2** 23rd April - 29th June
  - Term 3** 16th July - 28th September
  - Term 4** 15th October - 11th December
- **NCEA Exams** 10th - 30th November
- Entry criteria: 1. Sit KVC Placement Test  
2. Present last two school reports
- School ethos is “**Opportunities and Success for All**”.
- All international students can study a minimum of 8 hours ESOL per week during the school day.
- All students stay in carefully selected home-stays.
- Home-stays organised by our own Home-stay Co-ordinator, Lola Overton.
- Huge variety of seasonal sports offered including football, rugby, basketball & volleyball.
- School orchestra, choirs & rock bands.
